Logic level N-channel enhancement mode Field-Effect Transistor (FET) in a plastic package using TrenchMOS technology. This product has been designed and qualified to the appropriate AEC standard for use in automotive critical applications.



**Fig 2. Single-pulse and repetitive avalanche rating; avalanche current as a function of avalanche time**




**Fig 3. Safe operating area; continuous and peak drain currents as a function of drain-source voltage.**




**Fig 4. Transient thermal impedance from junction to mounting base as a function of pulse duration.**





**Fig 5. Output characteristics: drain current as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values.**





**Fig 6. Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of drain current; typical values.**





**Fig 7. Forward transconductance as a function of drain current; typical values.**





**Fig 8. Transfer characteristics: drain current as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values.**





**Fig 9. Gate-source threshold voltage as a function of junction temperature**





**Fig 10. Sub-threshold drain current as a function of gate-source voltage**





**Fig 11. Normalized drain-source on-state resistance factor as a function of junction temperature**





**Fig 12. Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values.**





**Fig 14. Input, output and reverse transfer capacitances as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values.**




